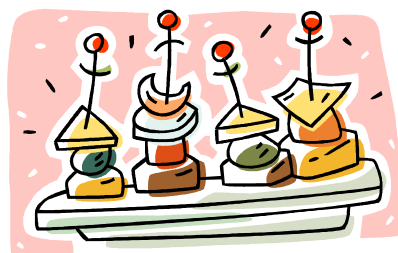


Upcoming Event
